Mitchell II series II were late model B-25D that eliminated the ventral (belly) turret. Additional features included side window guns in the rear fuselage and a tail cupola with a single .50 calibre machine gun; also 2 blister pack .50 calibre machine guns on each side of forward fuselage (usually removed by RAF). Due to occasional factory supply problems, some aircraft were shipped missing some of these additional features.
